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**EYFS** In EYFS, Music is not taught through discrete, timetabled lessons and units. Musical skills and understanding are taught and developed through continuous and enhanced provision, cross-curricular experiences, special events (such as the Christmas play), and collective worship. Specific skills are modelled, encouraged and developed by adults and experienced peers.
