Lledr Hall Residential Trip

In May, Year 5 children will be given the opportunity to have a residential stay at Lledr Hall. Lledr Hall is a Salford City Council Outdoor Education Centre and Salford children have been participating in stays there for many years.

There is an ever-growing body of evidence to support the view that participation in high quality adventurous activities improves attainment in education and enhances pupils' personal, social and emotional development. We are therefore trying to include the opportunity for as many of our pupils as possible to have this experience whilst at St Luke's.

The cost of this residential trip will be £150.00. This includes full board accommodation, transport from the school to the center and return, comprehensive insurance, all instruction and activities plus all safety equipment. This trip has been heavily subsidized by the school to keep the cost to you as low as possible. The trip will take place from Tuesday 5th May to Friday 8th May 2026. The cost can be paid either whole or in installments. There will be a payment plan available if preferred, the installment dates / amounts will be as followed:
