



# Year 2: Plants Knowledge Map

Subject Specific Vocabulary		Interesting Books	Sticky Knowledge about plants
<b>Roots</b>	A part of a plant that is usually hidden under the ground. They make the plant stable and give it nutrients.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ A bulb pushes out roots from its bottom and then a stem grows from the top.</li> </ul>
<b>Stem</b>	The stem is the main part of the plant. It supports the weight of the leaves, as well as the flowers or fruit.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ Roots will develop from a seed and push down into the soil. Then the stem stretches up, towards the light, to display the first leaves.</li> </ul>
<b>Leaves</b>	A part of a plant that is green and attached to the stem. It absorbs light.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ The roots anchor the plant into the soil and provide nutrients to the plant.</li> </ul>
<b>Bulb</b>	A resting plant		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ The leaves provide food and air to help the plant stay healthy.</li> </ul>
<b>Flower</b>	A part of a plant that contains seeds and is surrounded by petals.	<h3>Parts of plant</h3> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ The stem holds up the plant and carries water and nutrients around the plant.</li> </ul>
<b>Grow</b>	Becomes larger or greater over time.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❑ In order to grow and stay healthy, plants need water, suitable temperature and sunlight.</li> </ul>
<b>Habitat</b>	The place where a plant or animal lives. There are different kinds of habitats, such as grassland, forest, river, sea and desert.		
<b>Nutrients</b>	A substance that provides nourishment essential for the maintenance of life and for growth.		
<b>Temperature</b>	A measure of how hot or cold something is.
