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|--------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| continent | One of the several large landmasses on earth. |
| ocean | A body of salt water that covers nearly three quarters of the earth. |
| Equator | Is an imaginary line around the centre of the Earth. It is very hot at the Equator. It divides the Earth into the north and south hemispheres. |
| Physical features | Physical features show natural objects such as mountains and rivers. |
| Human features | Human features are things that are built by humans such as bridges and roads. |
| North pole | The North Pole is the northernmost place on Earth. When at the North Pole all directions point south. |
| South Pole | The South Pole is the southernmost place on Earth. When at the South Pole all directions point north. |
| desert | A desert is a very dry place that experiences little rain and therefore plants don't grow there. It is difficult to find water in a desert. |
| cliff | A very steep, vertical, or overhanging face of rock, earth, or ice. |
| coast | Is the area where land meets the sea or ocean, or a line that forms the boundary between the land and the ocean or a lake. |
| Harbour | A harbour is a deep body of water that protects boats near land. |

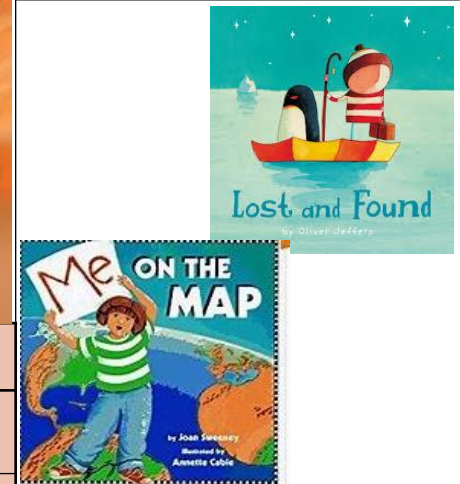
