

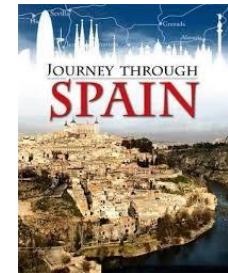
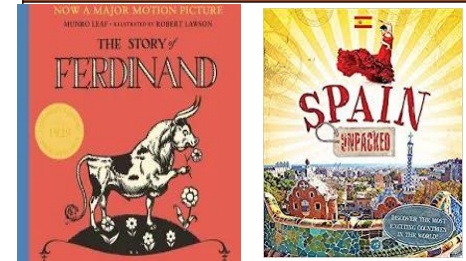
Year 3 'Europe' Knowledge Map

European Union	The EU tries to make it easier for Europeans to buy and sell things to each other.
United Kingdom	The four countries in The UK are England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
Euros	Euros is the currency used by many of the European Union countries.
paella	Paella is a dish cooked especially in Spain, which consists of rice mixed with small pieces of vegetables, fish, and chicken.
Brexit	It stands for Britain exiting the European Union. In a vote in 2016, adults in Britain narrowly voted for leaving the EU.
Compass	<i>An instrument that points North and can be used for finding directions.</i>
Mediterranean	It is a body of water that separates the continents of Europe, Africa and Asia.
Bull fighting	A sport, popular in Spain, where a person fights against a charging bull in a large arena surrounded by spectators.
Climate	<i>The weather conditions in a particular place</i>
